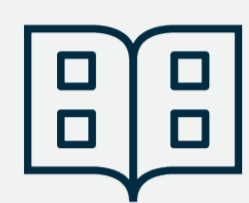


# Five steps to AI governance maturity

You've started exploring AI and know that AI Governance is going to be critical for success at scale. The word "governance" can sound overwhelming, but ensuring you have a sound framework in place from the start will help you collaborate and innovate faster, while reducing risk. By following these five steps, you will help your organization mature into an AI powerhouse, which is the key to gaining a competitive edge.



## STEP 1: Catalog AI use cases and data

First, start by taking an inventory of all current AI models and data being used to feed them. Make sure you consult with every department to ensure you have a complete understanding of your AI landscape.

## STEP 2: Reduce the risks of shadow AI

To reduce the risk of shadow AI, introduce an easy to use registration mechanism that captures the initial business information needed including ROI expectations and the intended audience.

## STEP 3: Collaborate, collaborate, collaborate

## STEP 4: Ensure explainability and traceability

## STEP 5: Continuously monitor performance and track ROI
